"The Art of Wisdom, Volume 1" Receives 2021 Da Vinci Eye Award

Tammy Lea Fabian's "The Art of Wisdom" Receives Award for a New Style of Devotional.

MCKINNEY, TEXAS—"The Art of Wisdom, Volume 1" received the <u>2021</u> <u>Da Vinci Eye Award</u> for its superior cover artwork, both in content and style. The Da Vinci Award is an annual honor associated with the <u>Eric Hoffer Book Award</u>, a monetary prize honoring the memory of American philosopher Eric Hoffer and awarded for salient writing and a small publisher's independent spirit.



Tammy Lea Fabian, author and owner of micropublisher Time in the Desert, explained, "I wanted to create a devotional on chapters 10-12 of the

Bible's book of Proverbs and put it in the form of a coffee-table art book that readers would enjoy leaving out as part of their decor. Since proverbs are the sayings and riddles of the wise, I wanted the cover to reflect that sense of riddle."

The cover depicts a timepiece resting firmly on a rock against a background of a stormy gray sea. Proverbs 10–12 teaches that "if we stand firm on a rock," Fabian said, "we will have a firm foundation just like the wise; however, if we live foolishly, we drown in the consequences of our choices."

While the cover is striking, the devotional content inside has also received favorable reviews. Wanting to tame her rebellious heart, Tammy Fabian began memorizing Scripture. A verse turned into a chapter, and a chapter turned into a book. To date, she has memorized twenty-three books of the Bible, including Proverbs, and she's still going, wanting to obtain a breadth of understanding and wisdom to share with others. Over time, her exercises of memorization turned to worship of the Lord, and that worship birthed "The Art
